

The 2010 ACR/EULAR Classification Criteria for Rheumatoid Arthritis

*Add Score of Categories A-D.
6/10 or great is classified as definite RA.*

A. Joint involvement

1 large joint	0
2–10 large joints	1
1–3 small joints (with or without involvement of large joints)	2
4–10 small joints (with or without involvement of large joints)	3
>10 joints (at least 1 small joint)	5

B. Serology

Negative RF <i>and</i> negative ACPA	0
Low-positive RF <i>or</i> low-positive ACPA	2
High-positive RF <i>or</i> high-positive ACPA	3

C. Acute-phase reactants

Normal CRP <i>and</i> normal ESR	0
Abnormal CRP <i>or</i> abnormal ESR	1

D. Duration of symptoms

<6 weeks	0
≥6 weeks	1
